Medical Neglect and Malpractice Complaint

This complaint by Plaintiff Dennis Sobin is against the Corrections Corporation of America and the following medical personnel: Carmen De La Rosa, Regulo Calaycay, Germelina Jongko, Cynthia Javellana, Leonila Llanera, Generoso Masangkay, Raul Ramos, Adelaida Torres, Nimal B. Singh, Leopoldo Villanueva, and Mariano Villaroman. Damages are in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000). The facts are as follows:

1. From approximately June 10 to July 20, 2005, plaintiff (who at the time was 61 years old) was incarcerated at the Correctional Treatment Facility in Washington, DC where he served a portion of a 90-day sentence following court proceedings involving his adult son Darrin Sobin and plaintiff's daughter-in-law Mylene Madela Montes.

2. Plaintiff's incarceration followed his hospitalization in Greater Southeast Community Hospital, Washington, DC, for a minor stroke that he suffered in a courtroom following proceedings that his son and daughter-in-law had initiated against him.

3. After being released from the hospital and following a short period at the DC Detention Facility, plaintiff spent the remainder of his incarceration at the Correctional Treatment Facility, operated by the Corrections Corporation of America. He arrived there with instructions from the hospital that he should be placed on a special diet.

4. Personnel of the Correctional Treatment Facility failed to adhere to these instructions in a timely manner. More than a month passed before he was placed on the recommended special diet and then he did not receive portions of it, including recommended fresh fruit. Plaintiff filed grievances in a timely manner, exhausting his administrative remedies.

5. The medical personnel named as defendants in this action refused to act on plaintiff's request that he be put on the recommended special diet.

6. As a result of plaintiff not being placed on the special diet and then denied full portions, he suffered a variety of medical ailments that have caused him pain, suffering, limited mobility and the need for medical services.

Plaintiff therefore seeks compensation for the damage he has suffered at the hands of the above defendants in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000).
